An exhibit to be staged on a wooden floor, by 1 or 2 people.

Space 122cm wide x 122 cm depth, height unlimited.

To be viewed and judged from the front.

COMPETITORS TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN BASE.

#### CLASS 2. "THE GREAT BRITISH SEWING BEE"

A free-standing exhibit to be staged on a wooden floor.

Spaced allowed 122cm x 122 cm, circular space with height unlimited.

To be viewed and judged all around.

## COMPETITORS TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN BASE.

#### CLASS 3. "NO MORE KNITTING".

A contemporary exhibit to incorporate wool.

To be staged on tabling covered with black fabric.\*

Space allowed 76cm wide x 60 cm deep, height optional, table height 74cm

To be viewed and judged from the front.

#### Class 4. "PATCHWORK". (Novice).

This means anyone who has not won a 1st prize at any Area Competitions.

An exhibit to include fresh and/or dried plant material and accessories.

To be staged on tabling covered with black fabric, table height 74cm.\*

Space allowed 50cm wide x 50cm deep, height optional.

To be viewed and judged from the front.

# CLASS 5. "LA BOITE A COUTURE". (A CRAFT EXHIBIT).

To be staged on tabling covered in black fabric. \*

Space allowed 50cm wide x 50cm deep, height unlimited, table height 74cm.

May be brought already assembled.

To be judged and viewed from the front.

# CLASS 6. "THE SEWING ROOM". (STILL LIFE EXHIBIT).

To be staged on tabling covered with black fabric. \*

Space allowed 60cm wide x 60cm depth, height optional, table height 74cm.

To be judged and viewed from the front.

### CLASS 7. "A PIN CUSHION". (A PETITE EXHIBIT).

To be staged on tabling covered with black fabric. \*

Space allowed 25cm wide x 25cm deep, height 37.5cm, table height 74cm.

May be brought already assembled.

To be judged and viewed from the front.

#### CLASS 8. "1948".

A FOAM FREE exhibit inspired by the film PALE FACE.

To be staged on tabling covered in black fabric. \*

Space allowed 76cm wide x 60cm depth, height unlimited, table height 74cm.

To be judged and viewed from the front.

### CLASS 9. "A MARY JANE SHOE" (JUNIOR CLASS).

An, exhibit to be displayed on a shoe box max 30cm wide x 30cm deep on tabling covered with black fabric, table height 74cm.\*

May be brought assembled.

To be judged and viewed from the front.

\*Walls and flooring are wood.

NB. Please note that until all entry forms are in we cannot complete an exact plan of classes. Therefore backgrounds may be wood panelling or centre of room.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS.

STAGING:- THURSDAY 30th May 2024. Between 12.00 and 4.30pm.

JUDGING TO COMMENCE AT 8.30am on Friday 31st May.

DISMANTLING:- Friday 5.00pm onwards.

Open only to clubs and members of Three Counties and South Wales areas of N.A.F.A.S.

TO BE JUDGED In accordance with the N.A.F.A.S. Competitions Manual Fourth Edition 2023.

No artificial plant material may be used.

Entries to be made on the form provided (photocopies allowed) must BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN SUNDAY 7th APRIL 2024.

IF COMPETITORS DO NOT RECEIVE AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR CONFIRMATION LETTER/EMAIL PLEASE LET COMPETITIONS SECRETARY KNOW.

Only one entry per person allowed in each class.

THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

Definition of a NOVICE (Class 4) Anyone who has not won a 1st prize at any Area Competitions. Prizes awarded at Virtual Shows should be discounted in this instance.

Exhibitors must arrange their exhibits without assistance. Care should be taken when using water and advise competitors to use a waterproof floor covering whilst staging.

Every effort has been made to give correct measurements for height of tables but could change slightly dependant on tables provided by venue. Competitors will be notified if this does happen.

Competitors positions will be allocated by the committee.

No responsibility can be accepted for loss or damage to exhibitors property on staging day or during competitions.
