Competition Schedule - 'ALL THAT JAZZ'

Class 1 – Hocus Pocus – An exhibit to be staged by up to two people. Competitors to supply own base if required.

Staging – floor, covered in dark blue carpet and cream background.

Dimensions – Width 122cm x Depth 122cm. Height optional.

To be viewed all round and judged from the front.

Limited to 4 exhibits.

Class 2 – Contemplation – A foam-free exhibit

Open tabling covered with black fabric. Table height 76cm from floor.

Space allowed – Width 61cm x Depth 61cm. Height optional

To be viewed and judged from the front

Class3 – Cocktails for two – An Art Deco exhibit

Open tabling covered with black fabric. Table height 76cm from floor.

Space allowed Width 76cm x Depth 76cm. Height optional.

To be viewed and judged from the front

Class 4 – It might as well be Spring – An exhibit.

Novice Class - entries only from those who have never won a first prize at an Area Show.

Open tabling covered with black fabric. Table height 76cm from floor.

Space allowed – Width 61cm x Depth 61cm. Height optional.

To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 5 – Souvenirs – A Steampunk exhibit

Staging – Open tabling covered with black fabric. Table height 76cm from floor.

Space allowed– Width 65cm x Depth 65cm. Height optional

To be viewed and judged from the front

Class 6 – La Fiesta - A pedestal exhibit. Competitors to provide own base if required.

Staging – floor in pale wood with cream background.

Space allowed – Width 122cm x Depth 122cm. Height optional.

To be viewed and judged from the front.

Limited to 6 exhibits.

Class 7– Bewitched – A petite exhibit. May be brought ready assembled.

Staging – alcove Width 30cm x Depth 30cm x Height 30cm

Space allowed– Width 25cm x Depth 25cm x Height 25cm

To be viewed and judged from the front.

Limited to 12 exhibits

Class 8 – Willow Weep for me – An exhibit featuring driftwood.

Open tabling covered with black fabric. Table height 76cm from floor.

Dimensions – Width 75cm x Depth 75cm. Height optional.

To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 9 – Wave – Craft class - A swag to include a hanging ring. May be brought ready assembled

Staging – Hook provided. Clear glass panel background

Dimensions – Width 30cm x Depth 15cm x Height 50cm

To be viewed and judged from the front

Limited to 12 exhibits

Class 10 a&b – Dreamland - An exhibit for juniors.

10a aged 8-11 years 10b aged 12-16

May be brought ready assembled

Open tabling covered with black fabric. Table height 76cm from floor.

Dimensions – Width 45cm x Depth 45cm. Height optional

30th April: Ready assembled exhibits only may be staged between 8.30am and 9.15am. No entries after this time

JUDGING TO COMMENCE:- 30th April from 9.30am

DISMANTLING:- 30th April from 4.30pm

Open only to clubs and members of Three Counties and South Wales Area of N.A.F.A.S.

Entries to be made on the form provided (photocopies allowed), and received no later than: 12th March 2025

A confirmation email will be sent on receipt of entry form. If a competitor requires a postal confirmation, please send a SAE with your entry form.

Only one entry per person allowed in each class

Definition of a NOVICE (Class 4) Anyone who has not won a 1st prize at any Area Competition. Prizes awarded at Virtual Shows should be discounted in this instance.

Exhibitors must arrange their exhibits without assistance.

Please consider others when setting up as space may be limited. Any spillages must be dealt with immediately. No aerosols to be used in the competition area.

Positioning of exhibits will be determined by the Show Committee.

No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to exhibitors' property during staging, or on Show day.
